Degree requirements

Completion of university studies of at least 6 semesters (Bachelor's degree) without limitation as regards content.

Practical Experience

At least 3 years (with less than 8 semesters of regular period of study: 4 years) of practical training with a Wirtschaftspruefer (WP) or a WP firm (or some other audit institutions), including primarily audit work for at least 2 years.

| • | How often does the examination take place? | Twice a year. |

| • | Do candidates have to take (and pass) all fields/topics of the examination in one single examination season, or can they modularize/split the different fields/topics into several seasons? | Candidates can modularize their examination: They have 6 years to complete all the 4 modules/topics. Every failed attempt to complete a module can be repeated twice. |
| • | Can candidates repeat the examination if they fail? How often? | If candidates fail to complete all the 4 modules/topics within 6 years, they can start a second period of 6 years with a "clean sheet". |
| • | What is the content (fields/topics) of the examination? | Reporting, Auditing, Assurance Engagements, Business Valuations and Professional EthicsApplied Business Administration, Economics Business Law Tax Law |
| • | Is it a written test or an oral test or a combination of both? | Combination of both (written test adding 60% and oral test adding 40% to the overall mark). |
| • | What is the format of the written tests: Multiple choice? Free text? | Free text. |
| • | Are the written tests paper-based? Or computer-based? | Paper-based. The implementation of computer-based written tests is aimed at within the next 3 years. |
