CAFR – Membership with audit from inside EEA/EU

To become a financial auditor in Romania, persons holding an equivalent qualification as a registered auditor in another EU country have to be authorized first by ASPAAS – the public interest oversight board, who has the ultimate responsibility for the access to the financial audit profession.

ASPAAS holds an annual aptitudes test for persons qualified in the EU who want to be financial auditors in Romania.

After CAFR receives the ASPAAS authorization order, the respective individual is required to submit a file containing specific documents to the Chamber, for registration purposes. The registration decision is then approved by the CAFR Council and the physical person is issued a membership certificate, stamp and membership card.
